THEIR HOUSES

Dear Brothers,

With this letter, I would like to remind you what our regulations indicate regarding the drafting of one's testament: "Before making the religious profession, we cede the administration of property to those whom we prefer and freely dispose of their use and usufruct. Before the perpetual profession we make a will that is valid also in civil law. To modify the will and to make any act related to personal temporal goods, the permission of the Major Superior is required" (Constitutions, 42). "Let the modification, however, at least for a considerable portion of the goods, not be in favor of the Institute" (Norms, 29).

I remind you that the "holographic" testament, that which is handwritten by the religious and then dated and signed, should contain elements of the following facsimile:

at (place), on(date)

(signature)

I invite you to transmit this information to the confreres and especially to the formators, and if necessary, to adapt it according to what is indicated in the civil provisions in the area of the Circumscription. The religious will write two authentic copies of the testament, one to be kept in the Archives of the Circumscription and the other in the Archives of the General Curia.
