CONVOCAZIONE OF THE XIII GENERAL CHAPTER

To all Rogationist Religious
THEIR HOUSES

Dearest Confreres,

In conformity with art. 141 of the Constitutions, with this letter, I hereby officially convoke the XIII Ordinary General Chapter of the Congregation.

I make this important undertaking, with the consent of the General Council, aware of the concerns caused by the Covid pandemic, trusting that we will have the opportunity to celebrate it regularly.

We all know the importance of this periodic appointment in the life of the Congregation which, as stated in the Constitutions, "has the supreme authority in the Institute and must be composed in such a way to represent the entire Congregation so as to be a real sign of its unity in charity" (art. 138).

The Constitutions also states that "the ordinary Chapter is always elective and is convened every six years, at the expiration of the term of office of the Superior General" (art. 140). Also, it specifies the tasks and aims of the Chapter:

"The essential task of the General Chapter, in a dynamic and creative fidelity to the charism, mission and tradition of the Institute, is to promote the renewal of spiritual life and the updating of the apostolic activities of the Congregation.

Its primary responsibility is:

1. to elect the Superior General, the Council, the Vicar and the General Treasurer;
2. to guard the spiritual and material heritage of the Institute¹;
3. to make a diligent revision of the religious life so as to solicit the Confreres to a fervent and renewed commitment to sanctification;
4. to renew and consolidate ever more the apostolic zeal for what is required by the fourth vow, in accordance with the orientations and directives of the Church;
5. to establish Norms for the entire Congregation"² (art. 139).

Following the provided procedure, with the consent of the General Council, I have arranged as follows :

1. The General Chapter will start on July 5, 2022.
2. It will be celebrated in the House of Morlupo, Rogate Spirituality Center.

3. On July 5, there will be a spiritual retreat; the Chapter members must be at the venue before 7:00 p.m. of the previous day, July 4.

4. Upon reception of this letter, each Religious, in personal prayer, will implore from the Divine Superiors the necessary graces for the success of the Chapter. Each Community will offer a monthly Mass for this intention. At the community's discretion, the prayers attached to this letter will be inserted in the daily practices of piety. I also invite you to sustain prayer with works of penance, charity, and assistance to the poor, especially the cloistered nuns, from whom we will ask for a special remembrance in their prayers.

5. As for the election of candidates, it shall be conducted as follows :

- a) Due to Covid-19, which has led to the difficulty of the movement religious in various places, it was considered appropriate to send the materials needed for the voting procedures of the delegates of the General Chapter online;
- b) On the homepage of our website, in the section General Chapter 2022, by entering with the personal mail rcj.org, you can find in pdf format all the documentation related to the voting procedures, for each Circumscription, in accordance with Appendix I of the Rules for the Composition of the Chapter (letter of convocation, list of members by right, list of religious with active voice, list of religious with passive voice, list of Coadjutors Brother, ballots for Priests/Deacons, ballots for Brothers);
- c) **the Superior and the Secretary of the Circumscription** may consider the possibility of directly downloading and printing the documentation and sending it by post to the Communities under their jurisdiction.
- d) alternatively, **the Superior and the Secretary of the Circumscription** will verify that the documentation is downloaded in the Communities;
- e) **the Superior of the Community** shall ensure that those who have the active voice write their preferences on the two ballots that are downloaded and printed, and put them inside the envelope and seals it; written on the front of the envelope are the name of the Circumscription and the title "Election of Delegates to the XIII General Chapter". Once the Confreres have completed the above mentioned procedure, on a specified date, **within two months from the date of the convocation** (cf. art. 144 of the Norms), at the latest on September 5, **the Superior of the Community** will assemble the Community and in the presence of all: - he will receive from the confrere-electors the envelopes which contain the ballots on which their preferred delegates are written; - he will put the said envelopes inside another bigger envelope, which will be sealed with the stamp of the House, and signed by him and his Councilors; - he, together with all the other Electors of the House, will sign the minutes of the session; - he will put the sealed envelope (containing the individual envelopes with the ballots) and the signed minutes of the session in another pouch, which he will send in a **safe and expeditious** manner to the General Curia.
- f) If a member of a different community resides in the community, he may vote with the members of that community, and this matter will be reported in the minutes.
- g) At the discretion of the Superior of the Circumscription, the parcels of the Houses can be sent all together to this Curia from the office of the Circumscription.
- h) If it happens that there is only one religious in the House, he votes according to the same procedure, reporting the matter in the minutes; the minutes and the envelope containing the two ballots will be placed in another envelope.

6. Once the pouches are received in the General Curia, during a special session of the General Council, possibly by September 28: a) the pouches will be opened in the presence of all the Councilors; b) the minutes of the House will be read and the number of envelopes will be checked if it corresponds with the number of the Electors of the House; c) then the opening of each envelope will begin, by Circumscription, followed by the scrutiny and the counting of votes; d) the list of the elected confreres will be communicated immediately to the Congregation, according to the provisions of Art. 143 § 2.3. Norms.


7. According to the procedure established by the current Norms (art. 147), after due consultation, the following particular theme has long been chosen: "*Rogationist religious life today – unity, coordination, sharing*". On February 15, 2021, the Commission on the Lineamenta sent a questionnaire to the Circumscriptions and Communities and examined the replies received.


8. Once the Delegates are defined, as provided by the Article. 147 § 2 of the Norms, the Pre-capitular Commission will be set up "to prepare the Instrumentum laboris for the Chapter, on the basis of the draft prepared by the previous Committee."


As I mentioned at the beginning, we hope that the pandemic will not affect the celebration of the Chapter. The Congregation for Institutes of Consecrated Life and Societies of Apostolic Life has issued a number of provisions in this regard: - on April 2, 2020, it authorized the postponement of the celebration of the general chapters; - on July 1, 2020, it transmitted the disposition of the Holy Father that "no general or provincial chapter could be held by means of telecommunications, or the combination of partial physical presence and partial presence through telecommunications, but only by means of physical presence"; - on May 31, 2021, it gave the possibility that until the year 2022, the chapter may be celebrated by means of telecommunications, but with a stringent set of conditions, including that the election of the Supreme Moderator and respective Council be made by post. The faculty to celebrate the General Chapter electronically does not abrogate the predetermined one that may be postponed until it can be celebrated in the ordinary form.

In the General Council, it was agreed that the convocation of the XIII General Chapter would proceed regularly, in accordance with the Norms, with the stipulation of assessing at the appropriate time the choice of a different modality.

With the hope that the next General Chapter could really be, according to its purpose, an important moment of growth and renewal of the Congregation, according to the will of the Divine Superiors, and through the intercession of our Founder, Saint Hannibal Mary Di Francia, I cordially greet you.

Attachment 1

Computation of the *quorum* and of the Chapter Members

***Quorum* of Chapter Members (49)**

According to the current Norms (Cf. Appendix I, n. 2), participating to the General Chapter are the 11% of all Priests/Deacons and perpetually professed Religious Brothers and perpetually professed Religious Students with active voice. This percentage constitutes the *quorum*. All those having the right to vote on the date of the convocation of the Chapter, on July 5, 2021, are 441. The XII General Chapter decided that the percentage is 11% (Minutes, Session 10, July 20, 2016, p. 10). The 11% of 441 Priests/Deacons and perpetually professed Religious Brothers corresponds to 48.51 which is rounded off to 49 (total *quorum*).

Participants by right (14)

Chapter members by right (Constitutions n. 191 § 1) are the Superior General (1), the General Councilors (4), the General Treasurer (1), the General Secretary (1), the Superiors of the Circumscription (7). (Total = 14). The former Superior General, who has become Bishop, is not entitled to participate (Authentic interpretation of the Pontifical Council for Legislative Texts, 17.V.1986 - AAS 78 (1986) 1324).

Delegates (35)

The number the Chapter Delegates resulting from the *quorum* (49) less the participants by right (14) = 35, which is composed of 33 Priests/Deacons and 2 Religious Brothers.

Priest/Deacon Delegates (33)

The total number of Priest/Deacon Delegates, being formed by the *quorum*, less those who participate by right (14), and less the two elected members from the list of perpetually professed Religious Brothers (2) is 33.

The number of Priest/Deacon Delegates for each Circumscription is obtained by subtracting the members by right of the same Circumscription from the number of Priests having passive voice and applying the following proportion: 391 (total number of Priests/Deacons with passive voice): 33 (total number of Priest/Deacon Delegates) = Y (number of Priests/Deacons with passive voice of each Circumscription): X (number of Priests/Deacons delegates of the same Circumscription). Based on the numbers, the result of the computation is as follows:

N.B. 7. To ensure a greater representation of the entire Institute, the Superior General may convoke to the General Chapter two perpetually professed Religious with active and passive voice. (Norms, Appendix I, Norms on the Composition of the General Chapter)

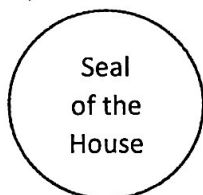
The Superior, having noted the presence of all, invited them to hand over their envelopes containing the filled-out ballots into a packet.
