Subject: United in prayer in the time of the Covid-19 pandemic

To: The Most Rev. Superiors of the Rogationist Circumscriptions and the Religious Communities

Dear Confreres.

For some weeks now, we have been living with a certain anxiety and alarm for the news that comes to us continuously about the trend of the coronavirus that initially affected China, at the moment Italy and Europe in a particular way, and continues to spread to most of the countries of the world, which has led to the declaration of the World Health Organization that we are now dealing with a pandemic.

Our sensitivity as children of Father Hannibal leads us in these circumstances to refer to faith and prayer, first in suffrage of the deceased, and then in support for those afflicted by the illness and their families, as well as the health professionals everywhere who are working devotedly with admirable availability and sacrifice.

For our part, we are trying to make best arrangements, according to our own possibilities.

With the invitation to remain united among us, imploring the protection of Divine Superiors, through the intercession of our heavenly protectors and of our holy Founder, I greet you with affection in the Lord.
