THE PROGRAM

The 'Formation of Formators' provides assistance to Priests, Religious Sisters and Brothers currently assigned or will be assigned in formation houses in the accomplishment of their responsibilities. The Program covers a variety of topics that are directly connected with the basic formation of aspirants or candidates, postulants and novices.
